

PROCEDURE FOR FIRST YEAR B.Tech. ADMISSION 2026-2027 (MS CAP, CAP-MI, TFWS and All India Seats)

1. Candidates who have been allotted a seat must fill and submit the online pre-admission form available on institute website <https://kjsit.somaiya.edu.in/en/>. **Steps for filling the form are given [here](#). (If this preadmission form is filled at home before coming to college, the admission process will take comparatively less time)**
2. Candidates should visit the institute for confirming the admission along with necessary documents in **original** and **four sets of photocopies** on or before the last date of reporting as per the schedule given by Maharashtra State CET Cell.
3. **On reporting to the institute**, Candidates will have to submit the all required documents in original (List is given below) along with **4 sets photocopies** of each document.

10.	Migration Certificate (in case of candidates passed H.S.C. examination from other than Maharashtra State Board)
11.	GAP Certificate (in case HSC Passed before 2026)
12.	APAAR ID Card (Photocopy) – One extra copy will be needed for originals set
13.	Aadhar Card (Photocopy) – One extra copy will be needed for originals set
14.	School Leaving Certificate mentioning Gujarati Language as mother tongue / Certificate issued by registered community regarding mother tongue of the candidate (For Minority Candidates)
15.	Proforma "O" for Minority Candidate
16.	Income Certificate (2025-26) Valid upto 31 st March 2027 for TFWS, EBC & Reserved Category Candidates, Girls Students claiming fee concession
17.	Caste Certificate (if required)
18.	Caste Validity Certificate (if required)
19.	Non-creamy Layer Certificate valid upto 31 st March, 2027 (In case of VJ / DT-NT(A)/NT(B)/ NT(C)/NT(D)/OBC and SBC)
20.	Proforma J and Proforma K and Proforma L and Proforma M (for J&K)
21.	Any other Certificate (if required as per category of candidate)

4. After verification and submission of the documents, the candidate's admission details will be entered in the Institute admission software.
5. Now, the candidate can proceed to the fees payment counter. Fees can be paid by the **Demand Draft** drawn on any Nationalized / Scheduled bank in favour of '**K. J. Somaiya Institute of Technology**' payable at Mumbai.

Fees can also be paid using online payment facility using our payment gateway. However, for online payment (internet banking / Debit Card / Credit Card / Gpay / UPI), please update the transaction limit of savings account to Rs. Two Lakh well in advance.

Note that, admission is not confirmed till the payment of the fees is not received by the institute.

** Other fees includes University Enrolment fee, E-Charges, Disaster Relief Fund, Students Insurance, Amartya Insurance, Sports & Cultural Activities, Cultural Activities Fund, Gymkhana Fees, Exam Fees, College I-card & Library Card charges, University eligibility charges, verification charges, processing fee etc. as applicable.

Note: Fee concession will be given only to those candidates who are eligible for concession as per rule prescribed by Government of Maharashtra and submit all required documents at the time of admission. In case, Competent Authorities does not approve the name of candidate for freeship / scholarship, he/she should pay the balance amount to the institute before the cutoff date given by the institute.
